\*VDOE - definition of seclusion - if someone else is in the room this is not seclusion - needs verification - FCPS includes "preventing the student from leaving" from inside the room (outside the room - seclusion)

\*Training has been requested by SROs - deescalation crisis intervention -- S Cooner has offered to support but it may be that they could watch the modules together - Brad to reach out to Judy Duprey

\*Possible presentation about FBA/BIP for ACSD as there seems to be confusion - Cynthia K is also willing to support (FBA/BIP core team)

\*The 45 day COVID-19 extension document is being removed

\*Validation error to push into SEA-STARS to support the maintenance of Service hours LD and LDV or LDF - need the plain base service must be paired with any proposed V or F or R service

\*Plain-English math accommodation is in process of being removed from IEP selection and should only be used for students who are pursuing a modified diploma and are trying to get credit for the grade 8 math SOL. The new math SOL (Algebra 1) was developed to incorporate this accommodation.
