We did set up a foundation of 10 max per rooms, however, we did limit enrollment due to staffing. We also did not combined bubble, to ensure health and safety measures. At Keene Mill.. each room has about minimum of 7 children.. We are using the SACC rooms for admin.. no children, because we do have staff that are not part of each bubble. There we are only using 7 FCPS classrooms.

But, we can meet to discuss as you continue to get in these requests, before we follow up with the principals.

Thanks for your email. I know you are trying to help figure this out and I appreciate it. I would be happy to meet online with you and Tony if we can find

a 30 minute time block that works.

I am working day and night to make a plan to get our students and teachers back in school. have to say that I have been up half the night worried about this situation, and am really struggling to understand how it takes precedence over the need to prepare our school for the return of students. With the need for us to have two isolation rooms and at least one child care room for teachers already, in addition to giving our teachers time to set up classrooms while they continue to teach, I'm not sure how to make this work. We are using our trailers for special education and WIDA testing in order to have proper space for students. The return to school plan will have all of our classrooms in use for instruction by the morning of Jan. 4, and teachers are on winter break as of Dec. 21. I don't mean to sound obstinate, but I won't require the upper grades to come in over winter break to set up their rooms for social distancing learning. They need ample time to work through how it will look and function, and should be allowed the same amount of time as their colleagues in other grades. We will need to have a two-week window for custodians to clean the rooms and teachers to set up before winter break. This would mean the program would need to be out of those rooms by Dec. 7.

We also need the rooms currently in use back for cleaning and set up by Nov. 9 for the same reason, as grades 1-2 return. These rooms need to be cleaned and set up as well.

To house the SRS program from Nov. 9 - Dec. 7 will mean that eight teachers who are currently teaching full time will have to prepare their rooms for the SRS. When our first grade teachers did this at the start of SRS, it took them each about a day to move instructional materials and personal items out of the way, and to gather things they need to teach, since they can't return to their classrooms during SRS. This is an unnecessary burden at the end of the quarter in the middle of this already challenging situation. It would also only allow the SRS program to be viable for an additional 18 days. I can't imagine that we will willingly put our teachers under this additional burden for such a short period of time.

You mentioned the Board of Supervisors, but to my knowledge, they don't have jurisdiction over Providence as a City of Fairfax-owned school. I have copied Dr. Pajardo here to enlist her help if needed.

At the start of the SRS program, Dr. Smith told us that the SRS program would be no additional burden on us as administrators or our staff members. To force an additional day of prep for our teachers now, and to require them to return to school over winter break to prepare would be an unreasonable request at this time when they are already working incredibly hard to teach under these unusual circumstances. I appreciate your help in figuring out how to avoid this additional work. Sincerely, Dan

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- When the program started, we put time and lots of consideration into how we could place the program to make it functional for families, to minimize interference with the ongoing meal distribution, and ensure that we could protect the "bubble" of the SRS group. We knew that the 8 Providence teachers whose rooms were being used were not going to be allowed to teach remotely in them or go into the bubble once it started, so they each took a day from the planning weeks to gather needed supplies and secure instructional and personal materials. The night before the SRS staff came in to set up, we were told not to use primary grade classrooms since they might be returning early. At that point, it was too late to bring in another group of 8 teachers to go through the same process in different classrooms.
- The program started and has been a great service for the families who signed up. Our own SACC leader is in charge and we consider her to be a part of our Providence family. The program has been self-sufficient since their first day with students. There are currently 41 children in the program, but only 13 of them are Providence students.
- Now that teachers and students are returning to our building, we have run into a shortage of classrooms. The SRS program originally requested 8 classrooms and has requested 9 as we move forward. They are only using 7 at this time. With the requirement that we have two isolation rooms for students in school, and our internal need for at least 1 child-care room, you

can imagine that space has become an issue. We simply don't have 12 extra rooms to cover all of these needs.

- We need to set up the first-grade classes so students can return on Nov. 30 and were asked to move from the current location to upper grade classrooms. This will require teacher to repeat the prep process above, while they are already feeling additionally stressed from their current teaching workload in this difficult environment.
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 - We need to make the current SRS rooms available for cleaning and set up by Nov. 16. This will give us a week for custodians to sanitize and rebuild, and a week for teachers to set up for socially-distanced learning to begin on Nov. 30.
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 - If we go through all of these steps above, SRS would still **only get additional 12 days** before needing to move again or cease operation. (Jeff and Vicki, my early-morning math was off by a few days. Sorry!) This feels like a lot of unnecessary burden for teachers and staff, with a minimal payoff for SRS.
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Please let me know if you need further information or see an error in my thinking. For now, I am going to keep working with our SRS leader to see what we can figure out. However, we are all crunched for time right now, and I feel the need to resolve this soon so I can plan appropriately with our teachers. I appreciate your consideration.

Hi Vicki,

Thanks for your email. I know you are trying to help figure this out and I appreciate it. I would be happy to meet online with you and Tony if we can find a 30 minute time block that works.

I am working day and night to make a plan to get our students and teachers back in school. I have to say that I have

been up half the night worried about this situation, and am really struggling to understand how it takes precedence over the need to prepare our school for the return of students. With the need for us to have two isolation rooms and at least one child care room for teachers already, in addition to giving our teachers time to set up classrooms while they continue to teach, I'm not sure how to make this work. We are using our trailers for special education and WIDA testing in order to have proper space for students. The return to school plan will have all of our classrooms in use for instruction by the morning of Jan. 4, and teachers are on winter break as of Dec. 21. I don't mean to sound obstinate, but I won't require the upper grades to come in over winter break to set up their rooms for social distancing learning. They need ample time to work through how it will look and function, and should be allowed the same amount of time as their colleagues in other grades. We will need to have a two-week window for custodians to clean the rooms and teachers to set up before winter break. This would mean the program would need to be out of those rooms by Dec. 7.

We also need the rooms currently in use back for cleaning and set up by Nov. 9 for the same reason, as grades 1-2 return. These rooms need to be cleaned and set up as well.

To house the SRS program from Nov. 9 - Dec. 7 will mean that eight teachers who are currently teaching full time will have to prepare their rooms for the SRS. When our first grade teachers did this at the start of SRS, it took them each about a day to move instructional materials and personal items out of the way, and to gather things they need to teach, since they can't return to their classrooms during SRS. This is an unnecessary burden at the end of the quarter in the middle of this already challenging situation. It would also only allow the SRS program to be viable for an additional 18 days. I can't imagine that we will willingly put our teachers under this additional burden for such a short period of time. You mentioned the Board of Supervisors, but to my knowledge, they don't have jurisdiction over Providence as a City of Fairfax-owned school. I have copied Dr. Pajardo here to enlist her help if needed.

At the start of the SRS program, Dr. Smith told us that the SRS program would be no additional burden on us as administrators or our staff members. To force an additional day of prep for our teachers now, and to require them to return to school over winter break to prepare would be an unreasonable request at this time when they are already working incredibly hard to teach under these unusual circumstances. I appreciate your help in figuring out how to avoid this additional work.

Thanks again for your support about SRS in the briefing last week. I am wondering if we have made any progress, and I know it was only a couple of days ago.

I spoke with our SACC leader, who is a valued member of our school family. She knows the situation we are facing and understands my perspective on it.

I have a possible solutions. First, we could manage the program for the 13 Providence SRS students in our SACC rooms, and can figure out how to share an isolation room. This would require finding a news space for the remaining 30+ students. Would it be possible to relocate them to a middle or high school since those students aren't returning until 2021?

I really don't know how we can support the program without a lot of work by our teachers to prepare for them move to an upper grade room. Even then, we would only get about two weeks of the program before they would have to move again the make room for grades 3-6. This would also require our teachers to come in and set up classrooms over winter break, so they can be ready for the Jan. 4 return.



Hi Vicki,

Thanks for your email. I know you are trying to help figure this out and I appreciate it. I would be happy to meet online with you and Tony if we can find

a 30 minute time block that works.

I am working day and night to make a plan to get our students and teachers back in school. I have to say that I have been up half the night worried about this situation, and am really struggling to understand how it takes precedence over the need to prepare our school for the return of students. With the need for us to have two isolation rooms and at least one child care room for teachers already, in addition to giving our teachers time to set up classrooms while they continue to teach, I'm not sure how to make this work. We are using our trailers for special education and WIDA testing in order to have proper space for students. The return to school plan will have all of our classrooms in use for instruction by the morning of Jan. 4, and teachers are on winter break as of Dec. 21. I don't mean to sound obstinate, but I won't require the upper grades to come in over winter break to set up their rooms for social distancing learning. They need ample time to work through how it will look and function, and should be allowed the same amount of time as their colleagues in other grades. We will need to have a two-week window for custodians to clean the rooms and teachers to set up before winter break. This would mean the program would need to be out of those rooms by Dec. 7.

We also need the rooms currently in use back for cleaning and set up by Nov. 9 for the same reason, as grades 1-2 return. These rooms need to be cleaned and set up as well.

To house the SRS program from Nov. 9 - Dec. 7 will mean that eight teachers who are currently teaching full time will have to prepare their rooms for the SRS. When our first grade teachers did this at the start of SRS, it took them each about a day to move instructional materials and personal items out of the way, and to gather things they need to teach, since they can't return to their classrooms during SRS. This is an unnecessary burden at the end of the quarter in the middle of this already challenging situation. It would also only allow the SRS program to be viable for an additional 18 days. I can't imagine that we will willingly put our teachers under this additional burden for such a short period of time. You mentioned the Board of Supervisors, but to my knowledge, they don't have jurisdiction over Providence as a City of Fairfax-owned school. I have copied Dr. Pajardo here to enlist her help if needed.

At the start of the SRS program, Dr. Smith told us that the SRS program would be no additional burden on us as administrators or our staff members. To force an additional day of prep for our teachers now, and to require them to return to school over winter break to prepare would be an unreasonable request at this time when they are already working incredibly hard to teach under these unusual circumstances. I appreciate your help in figuring out how to avoid this additional work.

Thanks again for your support about SRS in the briefing last week. I am wondering if we have made any progress, and I know it was only a couple of days ago.

I spoke with our SACC leader, who is a valued member of our school family. She knows the situation we are facing and understands my perspective on it.

I have a possible solutions. First, we could manage the program for the 13 Providence SRS students in our SACC rooms, and can figure out how to share an isolation room. This would require finding a news space for the remaining 30+ students. Would it be possible to relocate them to a middle or high school since those students aren't returning until 2021?

I really don't know how we can support the program without a lot of work by our teachers to prepare for them move to an upper grade room. Even then, we would only get about two weeks of the program before they would have to move again the make room for grades 3-6. This would also require our teachers to come in and set up classrooms over winter break, so they can be ready for the Jan. 4 return.

I do want you to know that I'm not trying to be hard-headed about this issue. I just feel the need to protect my teacher's time and prevent another stressful assignment when they are already struggling.





FCPS Community Use has been asked to assist in the logistical management of the SRS program.

Since this program is starting its 3rd month, there has been several changes that has occurred in our schools. More staff has returned, gradual-phased approach to provide in-person instruction, and the space needs of an active building.

SRS will remain as the standard instead of SACC at this time and for the foreseeable future. The *needs of SRS* are the same; 6 rooms, one isolation room, and the SACC room(s). Please review your current usage classroom assignments for SRS. Some might be utilizing more than the 6 classrooms+ and will have to reduce to meet the original needs of SRS. The 6 rooms +isolation +SACC classrooms must remain.

At some of our SRS facilities, the SRS current classrooms are located in the K-1 classrooms. With the anticipation of a phased in return beginning with lower grades we are asking for assistance in identifying other areas of your building where the SRS classrooms can be accommodated such as the 4-6 grade classrooms. It is understood by the SRS reps the need for these moves and the differences of in room amenities such as sinks. The objective is to try to keep the SRS classrooms as close together as possible. Please work with your SRS team at your facility to plan and implement your moves to allow for the necessary moving of equipment or furniture.

I am here to assist in any way that Community Use can while understanding that every part of this school year is anything but 'normal'. SRS is providing a huge service to our communities and is valued by FCPS leadership and Fairfax County Board of Supervisors.
