This is the sixth day of school and my children, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] still have no school work.

The feedback I've gotten of the first week being a bonding time is not sufficient, and still makes my point that they are missing out on social skills learning because of not having a reasonable accommodation for virtual learning. Additionally, there are a lot of assumptions and accusations being made about me, that I consider retaliatory in nature because I have chosen to exercise my children's lawful rights.

Please make reasonable accommodations under the ADA for [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] to participate in virtual learning, and send them schoolwork until it is set up.

Thank you for sharing this information. As Ms. Dalton shared with you, enrollment in the virtual school program is closed, at this time. If your children have a new medical condition, and you would like for them to be considered for homebound services, please work with Ms. Thompson, the social worker so she can provide you with needed paperwork for the process. Homebound services may be provided to students who have a medical condition preventing them from participating in classroom instruction because they are confined to home or a health care facility. The homebound instruction approval process requires medical documentation submitted by an approved medical professional and

information provided by school staff members. Based on the Virginia Department of Education Guidelines, FCPS' Out-of-School Support program manager or educational specialist determines eligibility for homebound instruction. Homebound instruction approval is determined on the basis of the documented need for service, taking into consideration less restrictive educational options and a student's participation in extracurricular or employment activities. Elementary students are generally provided with five (5) hours of instructional services per five-day school week.

Once you meet with your physician and have the completed medical forms, Ms. Thompson will follow up with you to complete the referral for the Out of School Support office to review. The IEP team will then convene to consider your child's needs as part of the process. Homebound support services can be provided in the home, in a public location such as a library, or virtually. If services are to be provided in the home, the social worker will coordinate with you to make a home visit prior to sending the referral to the Out of School Support Office.
