Hello Karin,

We had a discussion with VDOE about the total counts we submit for Dec1. No records are removed/deleted, they apply a filter and the final numbers we see in the VDOE report (28,027 students) includes only students who live in Fairfax County/Fairfax City.

The other 12 students who live out-of-county (Loudoun County, Prince William County, etc) are included in the report for their respective school districts (county/city where they live)

Back then, when we discussed with VDOE a couple of years ago, I recall that the discrepancy was on the opposite way, you had less students in your computer system (the count for Fairfax students) and that's why we needed a clarification from VDOE about the reasons why we see less students in our VDOE report than the ones actually reported in our final file. That was the reason, the VDOE report (screenshot below) includes only Fairfax County students.

It looks like now, your system (perhaps a different computer system) includes the count (28,039 students) for all students (Fairfax County and out-of-county students). I will prepare the file and just need to know if moving forward you will need two reports, Fairfax-County-students-only and ALL-students reports.

This could be a little confusing but would be happy to set up a meeting to discuss about these numbers and the datasets that meet your needs. Please let me know.

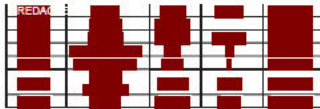

Hello Yixin, Karin and I went over the final Provider Caseload Report and she is going to call Jim to make sure we've included everything he needs before she sends it to you. I'd like you to be aware of the following regarding the report as the data in the report may or may not be current:

1. The caseloads are created in FCPSMED by the user.
2. The caseload information in the report may not be completely current. There is no way for us to determine who is actually currently providing services to which student for the following reasons:
 - a. Since this is the start of the year all users may not have created or updated their caseload yet in FCPSMED.
 - b. If a user did not update their caseload for this year and had students on their

- caseload from last year, then those students from last year are still listed on their caseload for this year even if they aren't providing services to them this year.
- c. Users that are not using our system to document for non-billable students may not necessarily add non-billable students to their caseload although they are providing services to the student. Some do and the student to their caseload and some don't.
 - d. Multiple users of the same User Job Title may have added one student to their caseloads, however, only one of the users is actually providing services to the student. In these cases you will see the student listed multiple times for that same service but the user's name will be different.
3. The same user may be listed multiple times in the report if the user added multiple students to their caseload.
 4. The following Job Titles only perform testing but may add students to their caseload in order to log for the assessment. Educational Diagnosticians who are SLPs and Psychologist ECAT. They do not provide therapy. They only provide testing. This also applies to some of the Audiologists.
 5. The report only includes OT, PT, SL, AUD and CL services along with the Psychological Assessments completed by ECAT Psychologists.
