

COVID -19 Compensatory Education Service Delivery Models

Individualized education program (IEP) teams and Section 504 Committees will discuss how compensatory education services will be provided. Teams may need to use a combination of service delivery options to meet students' needs. Additionally, teams will ensure there is clarity regarding when services will be provided making certain that an *appropriate and reasonable timeframe for completion* of the services is determined. When determining the service delivery model, modality for the provision of services, and timeline for service completion, teams will consider the individual educational needs of the student.
