Hi Jane,

Thank you for inviting my input. I attached an article from NASP on auditory processing which I think will guide your response. The article also says an audiologist should make the final diagnosis of CAPD (plus we don't diagnosis, only for Medicaid). Here is a draft response:

School psychologists have expertise in cognitive, social, and emotional development and therefore can provide comprehensive assessments in those areas. School psychologists have foundational knowledge and understanding of the common characteristics associated with other areas, such as auditory processing. When evaluating a child to determine if a more restrictive special education instructional environment is necessary to maximize learning, in addition to cognitive, social, and emotional assessments, the school psychologist administers other screening measures. These screening measures are selected based on the referral question, observations of the student, and performance during the individual assessment. If the screening measure(s) identify possible difficulty, a related services team member may be invited to conduct a more comprehensive assessment in that specific area.
